

The afterbirth (placental membranes) is usually expelled shortly after the calf is born but can take several days. Cows with retained placenta may require follow up veterinary attention. Calving time - The birth process - Presentation, position and - Dystocia. It is not needed when cattle are raised only for meat. Beef calves are allowed to stay with the mother and suckle for as long as they want. But dairy calves are separated from the cow soon after being born. This practice allows most of the milk to be collected and sold, rather than being consumed by the calf.
